Heavy rain have occurred at isolated places in coastal Andhra Pradesh.

Rain or thundershowers have occurred at many places in Assam & Meghalaya, at a few places in Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland-Manipur-Mizoram-Tripura, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Orissa, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, south interior Karnataka and Kerala and at isolated places in Haryana, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and coastal Karnataka. Very light rain has also occur at isolated places in Chattisgarh. Mainly dry weather prevailed over the rest of the country. **The chief amounts of rainfall in cms are:** Pathapatnam 6.8, Kailashahar 5.3, Passighat 4.8, Palasa & Tekkali 4.4 each, Tangla 4.2, Rangiya & Venkatgirikota 3.7 each, Bhubaneshwar AP 3.5, Tarikere 3.3, Dibrugarh 3.1, Gopalpur 2.5, Imphal 2.1, Cochi 1.8, Tiruvanthapuram AP 1.7, Ammathy 1.6, Cooch Behar & Dharmasala 1.5 each, Bhagamandala 1.4, Banihal, Gangtok & Gulmarg 1.1 each, Chandigarh, Kalingpong & Nahan 1.0 each, Jammu 0.8, Sidhapur & Solan 0.7 each, Amritsar & Chandbali 0.6 each, Mukteswar & Rajampet 0.5 each, Chickmanglur & Haliyal 0.4 each, Dehra Dun 0.2 and Jagdalpur & Ludhiyana 0.1 each.

Forecast: Rain or thundershowers would occur at many places in Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland-Manipur-Mizoram-Tripura, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir; at a few places in Gangetic West Bengal, Orissa, Haryana, north coastal Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, coastal & south interior Karnataka and Kerala and at isolated places in Jharkhand, west Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, east Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chattisgarh, south coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Rayalaseema and north interior Karnataka . Mainly dry weather would prevail over the rest of the country.
