

## CLIMATE OF SMART CITY - MORADABAD STATE :- UTTAR PRADESH, DIST :- MORADABAD

Climate of the city is characterized by a hot summer, a bracing cold season and general dryness except in the southwest monsoon season.
" Average annual Maximum Temp. is $30.4^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$.

- Average annual Minimum Temp. is $18.7^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$.
" Mean Maximum Temp. of Hottest Month (May) is $38.9^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$.
- Mean Minimum Temp. of Hottest Month (May) is $24.4^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$.
" Mean Maximum Temp. of Coldest Month (Jan) is $19.9^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$.
- Mean Minimum Temp. of Coldest Month (Jan) is $7.9^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$.
" Ever Recorded Maximum Temp. was $48.2^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ on $22^{\text {nd }}$ June 1985.
- Ever Recorded Minimum Temp. was $0.0^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ on $12^{\text {th }}$ Jan 1983.

"Average annual Rainfall is 107.7 cm .
- Average annual Rainy days are 42.
" Mean monthly highest rainfall observed in August is 34.4 cm .
- Mean monthly lowest rainfall observed in November is 0.3 cm .
» Ever recorded Heaviest Rainfall in 24 Hrs. is 40.0 cm on 12th February 1996.
- Rainfall during the southwest monsoon season is about $87 \%$ of Annual rainfall.
" Values of Relative Humidity are about $61 \%$ to $88 \%$ in the morning and $45 \%$ to $81 \%$ in the afternoon.
" During the south west monsoon season the skies are generally heavily clouded.
- In the winter season clouding is moderate.
"Rest of the year skies are lightly clouded.
- Thunderstorm occurs during January to June except in the month of February
Thunderstorm during February to June sometimes accompanied with duststorm.
- Thunderstorm during February, March and May sometimes accompanied with Hail.

Fog occurs during post monsoon and winter season and
 its frequency is maximum during winter and medium during post monsoon season.
